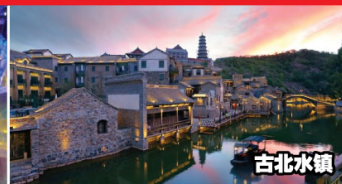

观光景点:



北京

- 王府井大街 - 全长约1600米的王府井大街是最受北京人民喜爱的商业区, 也是全国著名的购物天堂。王府井大街作为北京的寸金之地, 每天的销售额可以说是“日进斗金”。
- 天安门广场 - 位于北京市中心, 可容百万人举行集会是世界名城中最大的广场。
- 故宫 - 又名紫禁城, 是明清两代皇帝住过的皇宫。它位于北京市中心, 面积达72万平方米, 是世界上规模最大的宫殿建筑群。故宫可以分为两大部分, 南为工作区, 即外朝, 北为生活区, 即内廷。外朝内廷的所有建筑排列在中轴线上, 东西对称, 秩序井然。
- 国家大剧院 - 中国艺术表演的顶级殿堂、也是大众文化生活的活动区域。国家大剧院内设歌剧院、音乐厅、戏剧场、小剧场等四个专业演出剧场和一个多功能。
- 居庸关万里长城 - 长城全长6000多公里, 是世界上最伟大的建筑之一。长城始建于秦始皇时期, 经过历代的增补修筑, 现在我们能看到的长城几乎都是明代所建。
- 龙庆峡冰雕艺术展 - 龙庆峡景区每年冬季都会举办冰灯艺术节, 从1987年至今, 龙庆峡冰灯艺术展已成为北京冬季旅游的传统项目。冰灯展位于两山之间的龙庆峡水坝下, 水坝自然垂下的巨大冰瀑是冰灯展绝美的背景。
- 古北水镇 - 是一处在古村的基础上改造重建的古镇景区。古镇依水而建, 充满北方古镇的大气威严, 也有很多江南水乡的特色, 还可以泡温泉、品尝美食、免预约爬司马台长城、是京郊地区休闲度假不错的选择。
- 颐和园 - 原名清漪园, 始建于公元1750年; 1860年的第二次鸦片战争中, 清漪园被英法联军烧毁; 1886年, 清政府挪用海军, 军费等款项重修, 并于两年后改名颐和园, 作为慈禧太后晚年的颐养之地。
- 鸟巢国家体育场 - “鸟巢”是2008年北京奥运会主体育场, 乃可容纳9.1万人的体育场。
- 水立方游泳馆 - 因表面看如一个装满水的立方体所以俗称“水立方”为奥运主要的水上项目比赛场馆。
- 天坛 - 中国现代最大坛庙建筑, 它乃明、清两代帝王祀天祈谷的坛庙, 主要包括祈年殿、皇宇、回音壁、圉丘、斋宫等。
- 秀水街 - 秀水街市场地处长安街延长线, 紧邻国际CBD 商圈, 地理位置显赫, 交通便捷, 是与长城、故宫相齐名的中国最具时间影响力的国际旅游购物市场。

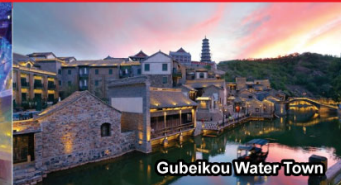

BEIJING

- **Wang Fu Jing Street** - It's the most famous commercial district selling daily necessities, hardware, electrical items, garments, jewellery, diamonds, gold and silver etc.
- **Tian An Men Square** - Which located at the center of Beijing. Tian An Men Square is the largest square in the world and can hold about one million people in the same time. It is surrounded by the Forbidden City in the north, the Great Hall of People in the west and museums of Chinese History and Chinese Revolution in the east.
- **Forbidden City** - The largest and best preserved collection of ancient buildings in China. The complex is divided into two sections - Inner Court - the living quarters and Outer Court - the working area.
- **National Centre for the Performing Arts** - This building contains three performing venues: the Opera House, the Concert Hall, and the Theater. In addition, the center has underwater corridors, an underground garage, an artificial lake and the green space.
- **Great Wall** - Is a series of stone and fortifications in China, built, rebuilt and maintained between 5th Century and 16th Century to protect the northern borders of Chinese Empire from Xiongnu attacks during the rule of successive dynasties.
- **Longqing Gorge** - You will see the Longqing Dam. The 230-foot-high (70-meter-high) dam is inset between hills. Looking to the north side from the dam, the picturesque scenery of hills and white clouds reflected in deep green water can be appreciated.
- **Gubeikou Water Town** - This town possesses an old-fashioned simplicity and elegance. Row upon row of house, old quartzite streets and long Hutongs shows the style and features of the old town.
- **Summer Palace** - This Imperial Garden covers area of 290 hectares. Longevity Hill and Kunming Lake are the few beautiful sites in Summer Palace. UNESCO included the Summer Palace on its World Heritage List. It declared the Summer Palace "a masterpiece of Chinese landscape garden design."
- **Beijing 2008 Olympic Stadium** - Is the main stadium of the 29th Beijing Olympic Games. The National Stadium in Beijing, the main stadium for the 2008 Olympic Games, is dubbed the "bird's nest" because of its innovative grid formation.
- **The National Aquatic Centre** - Also called the "Water Cube", The center will be the venue for swimming, diving, synchronized swimming and water-polo final during the Olympic Games.
- **Temple of Heaven** - Is a place where the Ming & Qing Dynasty went to worship Heaven and pray for good harvest.
- **Silk Market** - Used to be an outdoor market, it now becomes a shopping mall, which accommodates over 1,000 retailers and is regarded as one of the symbols of Beijing together with the Great Wall, the Summer Palace, and roast duck.
